Tenth Station

Jesus Is Stripped of His Clothing

By this time Jesus was so weak he was unable to resist anything the soldiers did to him. They cruelly ripped off his clothing, and they quarrelled over who would have it. "For his part, he made no resistance, neither did he turn away. The Lord God came to his help so that he was untouched by their insulting behavior" (Isaiah 50:6). Jesus stood there stripped and humiliated, waiting to be nailed to the cross.

(Recite the following with hands clasped behind back.)

If we had been there, Jesus, those soldiers wouldn't have laid a hand on you. We would never have allowed them to touch your clothing or to humiliate you in any way.

But we weren't there. We are only here now, remembering.
